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LOCAL DEVELOPER CHANGES NAME

Landmark Properties Group now known as Pittman Development Group

Denver, CO (**April 2, 2008**) – Landmark Properties Group, Inc., the Denver-based real estate development company, has changed its name to Pittman Development Group, Inc. The change has been made to avoid confusion with other Landmark named properties, projects, and businesses in the metro area, and to better identity the company with its founder and president, Ray Pittman.

Recent accomplishments include the creation of High Point - a multi-jurisdictional 1,800-acre master planned community near Denver International Airport, and the company's successful bid to acquire the 165-acre Fehringer Ranch property in Jefferson County from Denver Water. The company has also been closely involved with efforts to bring a new auto racing speedway/stadium and NASCAR style racing to the Denver metro area. Current projects include High Point OmniCenter Phase I, which will provide 91,490 square feet of new class A flex office space near Denver International Airport.

Company founder Ray Pittman has been involved with the successful development of over 4,400 acres of mixed-use and commercial land projects, including the 1,800 acre High Point project, the 1,796 acre Village at Avon, the 295 acre Stapleton Business Center, and the 294 acre EastGate Business Center. Pittman has also been involved with the development of over 2 million square feet of office, industrial and flex space throughout the Denver Metro area.

Founded in 2003, Pittman Development Group is a Denver-based developer committed to the creation of high-quality, mixed-use communities and workplace environments throughout Colorado. Through careful attention to community objectives, respect for the natural environment, and the application of "smart growth" planning principles, the company strives to create vibrant, sustainable projects to serve residents, employers and employees alike.

Prior to founding the Pittman Development Group, Ray Pittman spent 14 years in commercial real estate services with CB Richard Ellis and five years with Catellus Development Corp., and has managed some of Colorado's largest and most prominent commercial and mixed-use developments.
